Atlanta Metropolitan State Selected as a "Head of the Class" Venue in Georgia by Unique Venues

Atlanta (Jan. 11) — The Easley Pavilion & Conference Center at Atlanta Metropolitan State College (AMSC) is one of "12 Best College & University Campuses in Georgia that Pass the Test" for Unique Venues, "a marketing and membership organization committed to bringing together one-of-a-kind event venues with meeting planners who are ready for something new," focusing on non-traditional venues such as college and university event spaces.

The Charles F. Easely, Sr. Pavilion & Conference Center opened fall 2013. The main room has the capacity to hold up to 800 individuals. The venue has meeting spaces that can hold as few as 10 individuals to 60 or more. And each space is equipped with audio visual equipment and individually controlled lighting. The venue hosts a variety of events including corporate gatherings, community meetings, and weddings. The venue hosts over 100 external events and over 200 internal events annually.

The venue is named for Charles F. Easley, Sr., Atlanta Metropolitan's first and longest serving dean of students and vice president for student affairs.
