

Elective options: Students with courses remaining for graduation may take elective courses to fill out their schedules. These classes include foreign languages, psychology, sociology, anthropology, public speaking, human communication, geography, and philosophy. Arts appreciation courses, Students may take courses not appearing in the state Accel/MOWR directory if they pay for these themselves, but these courses do not receive high school credit.

Students are instructed to present proposed class schedules to their high school counselors for final approval prior to AMSC course registration. Accel and MOWR applications will be completed after students have been accepted to AMSC and advised by the Special Program Director.

3. By signing this form, the counselor, parent and student give their consent for the student to be enrolled in the AMSC Dual Enrollment Program and understand which successfully completed AMSC courses will satisfy the student's remaining requirements for high school graduation. At the end of each semester, the AMSC Registrar's Office will mail a transcript with grades earned while in Dual Enrollment status to the high school. The student also understands that a signed copy of the AMSC Policy Statement, to be distributed after admission, must be returned to the Special Programs Office as a condition of participation in the Dual Enrollment Program.
