



POSITION ANNOUNCEMENT

Assistant Professor of Physics and Engineering

Atlanta Metropolitan College, a two-year degree-granting institution of the University System of Georgia, is accepting applications for an **Assistant Professor of Physics and Engineering**. Atlanta Metropolitan College currently serves 2300 commuting students on a beautifully landscaped campus, which is located 10 minutes south of downtown Atlanta, and 15 minutes north of the Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport.

THE POSITION

This is a full-time, tenure track, ten-month faculty position, which reports to the Chair of the Division of Natural Sciences. Applicants should display an interest in promoting the development of the science program, which includes undergraduate research initiatives. The applicant must have a history of effective teaching at the collegiate level and possess knowledge of current trends in science education and educational technologies (e.g. Web-based and/or Web-enhanced instruction). The position also requires serving on division and college committees, assisting in the development and improvement of the science curriculum, and advising students.

QUALIFICATIONS

A Master's degree is required (Ph.D. preferred) with eighteen graduate semester hours (thirty-quarter hours) in Engineering and/or Physics is required. Preference will be given to applicants with expertise and experience in on-line instruction and/or certification in a related field. The successful candidate will have experience providing instruction to students from diverse backgrounds, while effectively collaborating and cooperating with other members of the faculty, staff and administration.

SALARY AND BENEFITS

The salary is commensurate with qualifications and experience. The University System of Georgia offers an excellent benefits package, including sick leave accruals, paid holidays, life and health insurance, and retirement plans.

APPLICATIONS

Review of applications will begin immediately and continue until filled. The anticipated employment date is August 17, 2009. Interested persons should submit (1) a letter of application, including a statement of the applicant's philosophy of education; (2) copies of **all** college transcripts (***candidates selected for interview will be required to provide official copies of all college transcripts***); (3) a detailed vita or resume; and (4) the names, current addresses, and telephone numbers of three professional references.
