Immunization Mobile Unit Scheduled for AMC Campus

Applicants for admission to Atlanta Metropolitan College are required to provide verification that they have been immunized for measles, mumps, rubella, varicella, tetanus diphtheria, and hepatitis B (*required for applicants 18 years old or younger*). The Fulton County Department of Health and Wellness Mobile Unit will provide immunizations at Atlanta Metropolitan College for:

**Applicants or Students for the Fall 2009 and Spring 2010 Semesters
on Tuesday, August 11, 2009,
in the Student Center, Conference Room B
From 9:00 a.m. until 12:30 p.m.**

Applicants and students will be responsible for all fees at the time of service. The following are acceptable forms of payment: check, money order, cash, Medicaid and PeachCare. Those applicants or students who are enrolled in Medicaid and PeachCare must present their card at the time of service. Credit cards or debit cards will not be accepted as forms of payment.

Adult MMR-Measles, Mumps, Rubella	\$ 14.81
Adult Varicella	\$ 14.81 (Varicella Immunization will not be Administered at AMC.)
Adult Tetanus, Diphtheria (19 yrs. +)	\$ 14.81
Hepatitis B	\$ 14.81

If possible, please bring records of any immunization shots that you received in the past.

Please notify the Office of Admissions at admissions@atlm.edu of the time that you will arrive on the campus on August 11, 2009 for immunizations.

- Applicants who are under 18 years old must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian.
- The Fulton County Department of Health and Wellness mobile unit does not administer the required Varicella vaccine. Applicants may receive the Varicella vaccine at any of the Fulton County Clinics listed on the 2nd page of this announcement.
