



POSITION ANNOUNCEMENT  
*Assistant Professor of Mathematics*

Atlanta Metropolitan College, a two-year degree-granting institution of the University System of Georgia, is accepting applications and nominations for **two full-time Assistant Professor of Mathematics** positions. Atlanta Metropolitan College currently serves over 2200 commuting students on a beautifully landscaped campus located 10 minutes south of downtown Atlanta and 15 minutes north of Hartsfield-Jackson International Airport.

**THE POSITION**

These ten-month, tenure track faculty positions report to the Chair of the Division of Business, Mathematics and Computer Science. Teaching assignments typically include Mathematics courses taught at the freshman and sophomore levels, although other courses (e.g., developmental Mathematics) may be assigned. Applicants must have a history of effective teaching at the collegiate level and possess knowledge of educational technologies (e.g., Web-based and/or Web-enhanced instruction). The position also requires serving on division and college committees, advising students and providing student support.

**QUALIFICATIONS**

A Master's Degree from a regionally accredited institution is required (an earned doctorate is strongly preferred) with a minimum of eighteen graduate semester hours (thirty-quarter hours) in Mathematics. Preference will be given to applicants with the credentials needed to teach courses in a related discipline; with experience in writing and/or managing grants or special projects, and with experience in developing and assessing curricular components (e.g., courses, program and learning outcomes). Successful candidates will demonstrate the ability to provide quality instruction to students with diverse backgrounds, exhibit a spirit of collegiality, and demonstrate willingness to effectively collaborate and cooperate with other members of the faculty, staff, and administration.

**SALARY AND BENEFITS**

Salaries are commensurate with qualifications and experience within the budgetary parameters of the college and of the University System of Georgia. The University System offers an excellent benefits package, including sick leave accruals, paid holidays, life and health insurance, and retirement plans.

**APPLICATIONS**

Review of applications and nominations will begin immediately and continue until the position is filled. The anticipated employment date is August 1, 2009. Interested persons should submit (1) a letter of application, which includes a discussion of the applicant's philosophy of education; (2) a detailed vita/resume; and (3) copies of all college transcripts; (***candidates selected for interview will be required to provide official copies of all college transcripts***) and (4) the names, current addresses, and telephone numbers of three professional/work related references, including at least one reference from the applicant's current or most recent employer.
