STATE OF GEORGIA

To get started doing business with the State of Georgia, you need to visit the Vendor Registration System.

The Vendor Registration System is a free web-based system provided by DOAS' State Purchasing that enables vendors to register their company and identify product and service offerings. State and local governments can search the Vendor Registration System by commodity, service, geographic location, and small or minority business status to locate vendors. The Vendor Registration System will automatically notify vendors by e-mail when related bids and procurement opportunities become available.

CITY OF ATLANTA

To do business with the City, secure a Bidder's Application Package from the Department of Procurement ("DOP"). Follow the instructions in the package, complete all the requested information, and return the application to DOP. Based on the information you provide and the items you select in the application, DOP will inform you, by its Invitation to Bid notices, of projects out-for-bid or proposals.

It is the mission of DeKalb County Purchasing & Contracting to provide fair and equal treatment to all persons, both County departments and vendors, involved in the procurement process. All contracts for the purchase or lease of goods, services, insurance or construction are awarded through competitive bidding or negotiations, or through other processes established by Federal statutes, Georgia law, and County Code. The first step in doing business with DeKalb County is to complete the necessary application forms to be listed as a prospective bidder.
