

Complaints of Title IX Sexual Misconduct

Title IX is a federal law that prohibits sex-based discrimination, including pregnancy-related discrimination and sexual harassment/sexual violence, in all activities and programs of educational institutions receiving federal funds, which includes Atlanta Metropolitan State College.

Title IX Coordinator
